## HELPFUL SHIPPING HINTS FOR THE HOLIDAYS FROM POSTNET

### *Tips for people who need to ship presents and gifts:*

§ Be sure to use a new cardboard box for shipping, old used boxes don't hold up as well in today's automated systems, and insurance is not covered with used packaging.

§ Make sure each package is clearly labeled with BOTH the recipient's and sender's addresses, it's also a good idea to put the address information inside the box too.

§ Call the package recipient ahead of time, so that he/she knows to expect a delivery, unless it's a surprise!.

§ Items that could possibly leak need extra care in packaging and shipping

§ For additional peace of mind, use services like UPS and FedEx® who offer customers guaranteed delivery times, include automatic insurance and the ability to easily track packages via the telephone or internet from origin to destination.

§ People traveling during for the holidays might consider shipping holiday gifts ahead of time instead of bringing these items on the airlines. New security regulations and size restrictions on carry-on baggage make this a more attractive option.

§ People who want help to securely package and ship their holiday gifts can bring them to a PostNet to have them packed by trained and experienced professionals. We have the materials, expertise and courteous service to help!

### **Packaging Guide**

- Choose a sturdy, corrugated box.
- Insurance claims may be void if box is not new.
- Place the gifts you want to ship in the box. Pack as close as you can and fill all space with Styrofoam peanuts or other packing material.
- Items should not move within the box or they may be damaged.
- Remember that fragile items need to be bubble wrapped and surrounded by extra peanuts.
- Seal the box with packaging tape.
- Please do not use masking tape or duct tape.
- Please do not wrap your packages in brown paper or tie them with string.
- Your package should be able to sustain a 3 foot drop, vibrations, and the possibility that another heavy package could fall on top of yours.
- Label your package and bring to our PostNet store for shipping.

## **SAINT PAUL USHERS IN THE HOLIDAYS WITH WELLS FARGO WINTER SKATE AND RICE PARK POWERED BY XCEL ENERGY**
